

Welcome to Navarino Nature Center and Navarino Wildlife Area!

The 211 species on the checklist follow the order in *Wisconsin Birds – Field Checklist*, 2002 of the Wisconsin Society for Ornithology, Inc.

Abbreviations imply relative ease of finding any species in a season (Sp, Su, Au, Wi).

- c common in suitable habitat
- u uncommon – usually present but not easily seen or heard
- r rare – observed most years but in small numbers
- vr very rare – only noted a few times in the Wildlife Area
- ir irregular – could be common, or absent in migration
- [] in migration

Italicized species are confirmed or likely breeders in the Wildlife Area.
